#### Lobo Athletic Club Minutes

Board Members present were Nick Martell, Laura Chabarria, Edward Chabarria , and Maria Gomez. Also present Principal Hinojosa, Coach Davis and Coach Robinson.

Principal's report: The mariachi group was one of three finalists in a 4A competition. The Lehman Mariachi's finished third and did an outstanding job. Financial Aid will be available for seniors enrolling in college on Saturday February 6 and February 13 at Hays High School. Lehman High School will also have these services on February 20<sup>th</sup> and March 6. March 3<sup>rd</sup> will be the English Task test. April 27,28,29 and 30<sup>th</sup> the Math task test will be held. The money for the purchase of the school marquee is complete. School would like to purchase a 16 foot marquee but city ordinance will only allow an 8 foot marquee.

Coach Davis hoping to play freshman football teams on the new turfed football field next season. Spring sports are under way baseball, softball, soccer and track. Spring Banquet is May 2<sup>nd</sup> at the PAC. Dinner starts at 5:30 and award ceremony at 6:30. Mr. Chabarria and Coach Davis are going to get a price bid for catering the banquet at Wilhites and Palmar in Buda. The invoice for the fall banquet has been turned in to the treasure. February 25<sup>th</sup> is the junior relay at Hays from 4-10p.m.. February 27 is the Lobo relay from 9 a.m.- 6 p.m..

President's report: Nick is taking merchandize to the soccer concessions booth. Merchandize will be brought out to the Lobo relay on February 27<sup>th</sup>. Applications for scholarships need revision and update. Julius will be on the scholarship committee. The raffle tickets need to be printed.
